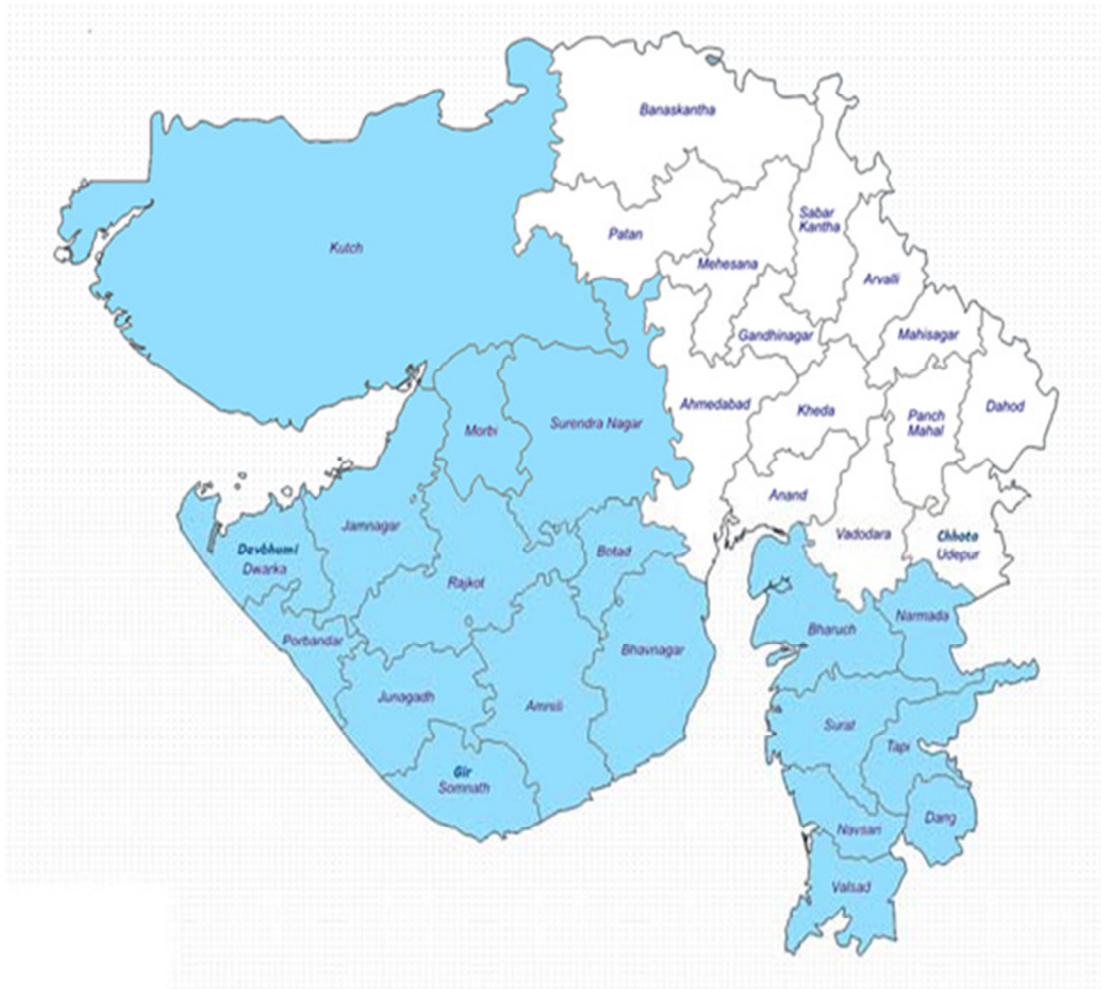

1.	<u>Mandavi</u> (District- Kutch)	2	Shaktisinh Gohil, former leader of Opposition of Gujarat Assembly and senior leader of Congress party has filed his nomination from this constituency. This year, he changed his constituency from Abdasa to Mandavi.
2.	<u>Anjar</u> (District- Kutch)	4	Former Minister and BJP leader Gopalbhai Ahir is contesting assembly election from this constituency.
3.	<u>Dasada</u> (District- Surendranagar)	60	The constituency is reserved for Scheduled Castes. Current speaker of Gujarat Assembly Ramanlal Vora is contesting assembly election from this constituency
4.	<u>Rajkot West</u> (District-Rajkot)	69	The incumbent Chief Minister Vijay Rupani represents this constituency. This year too, Mr Rupani is contesting from this constituency. Congress has fielded Indranil Rajyaguru against him. He is the existing MLA of Rajkot East constituency.
5.	<u>Jasdan</u> (District-Rajkot)	72	The present Member of Parliament of INC Kunwarjibhai Mohanbhai Bavaliya is contesting from this constituency.
6.	<u>Jetpur</u> (District-Rajkot)	74	Jayesh Radadiya, the sitting BJP MLA and Minister, is contesting from this constituency.
7.	<u>Jamnagar(Rural)</u> (District-Jamnagar)	77	Raghavjibhai Patel, who was elected on INC ticket from this constituency in 2012. Later, he left Congress and joined BJP. He is contesting against Vallabhbhai Dharaviya of INC.

8.	<u>Jamjodhpur</u> <u>(District-Jamnagar)</u>	80	The current Agriculture Minister Chimanbhai Sapariya represents this constituency. He is facing Chiragbhai Kaleria of Congress.
9.	<u>Porbandar</u> <u>(District-Porbandar)</u>	83	The sitting MLA and incumbent Minister Babubhai Bokariya is facing Arjunbhai Morwadiya of Congress.
10.	<u>Visavadar</u> <u>(District-Junagadh)</u>	87	Former Chief Minister of Gujarat Keshubhai Patel was elected from this constituency in 2002 assembly elections representing Gujarat Parivartan Party, but later resigned in 2014 due to ill health. He was a member of BJP till 2012. BJP candidate Kirit Patel faces Congress candidate Harshadbhai Ribdiya.
11.	<u>Somnath</u> <u>(District-Gir Somnath)</u>	90	Jashabhai Barad of Congress who represented this constituency in 2012 assembly election left Congress and joined BJP. In this election, he is battling against Vimalbhai Chudasama of Congress.
12.	<u>Bhavnagar (Rural)</u> <u>(District- Bhavnagar)</u>	103	Senior BJP leader and former Minister Parshottam Solanki is contesting from this constituency. Mr Solanki is Koli Patel leader which is dominant community in the district. He is facing Kantibhai Chauhan of Congress
13.	<u>Bhavnagar West</u> <u>(District- Bhavnagar)</u>	105	Jitendra Vaghani, President of state unit of BJP represents this constituency. He is contesting against Dilipsingh Gohil of Congress in this constituency.
14.	<u>Gadhada</u> <u>(District- Bhavnagar)</u>	106	This constituency is reserved for Scheduled Castes. The incumbent Minister Atmaram Parmar is contesting against Pravin Maru of Congress. The famous Swaminarayan Temple is located here.
15.	<u>Amreli</u> <u>(District-Amreli)</u>	95	Former Minister Bavkubhai Ughad is contesting against senior Congress leader and existing MLA Pareshkumar Dhanani.

16.	<u>Dediyapada (District-Narmada)</u>	149	The constituency is reserved for Scheduled Tribes. BJP leader Motilal Vasava is contesting against Maheshbhai Vasava of Bharatiya Tribal Party. BTP is recently established party by Chhotubhai Vasava, an existing MLA of JD(U).
17.	<u>Jhaghadiya (District-Bharuch)</u>	152	This constituency is reserved for Scheduled Tribes. BJP leader Ravajibhai Vasava is facing Chhotubhai Vasava, who is a supporter of former JD (U) leader Sharad Yadav, representing Bharatiya Tribal Party. JD (U) has also fielded a candidate with the similar name as Chhotubhai A. Vasava.
18.	<u>Bharuch (District-Bharuch)</u>	153	This constituency has a significant number of minority and Dalit population. Dushyant Patel of BJP is contesting from this constituency for the third time. Jayesh Patel of INC is also contesting.
19.	<u>Jambusar (District-Bharuch)</u>	150	Jambusar is tribal dominant constituency. BJP has once again fielded incumbent Minister Chhatrasinh Mori while Congress has given ticket to party leader Sanjay Solanki.
20.	<u>Mangrol (District-Surat)</u>	156 (ST)	Incumbent Minister Ganapat Sinh Vasava is representing BJP in this ST reserved constituency. Nansingbhai Vasava of INC is another prominent candidate.
21.	<u>Varachha</u>	161	All the constituencies of Surat district are Patidar dominated constituencies.

1.	Vav (District-Banaskantha)	7	BJP Minister Shankarbhai Chaudhari represents this constituency. He is contesting against Geniben Thakore of Congress.
2.	Vadgam(Reserved for SC) (District-Banaskantha)	11	Dalit leader Jignesh Mewani is making political debut from this constituency as an independent supported by the Congress. Ashwinbhai Parmar is also contesting as an independent while BJP has fielded Vijaykumar Chakrawarti .
3.	Diyodar (District-Banaskantha)	14	Incumbent Minister Keshaji Chauhan is contesting election from this constituency. He is also a BJP District President.
4.	Radhanpur (District-Patan)	16	This constituency has large number of Thakore population. OBC leader Alpesh Thakore, who joined Congress before the election, has been given a ticket from this constituency. Lavingji Solanki is contesting on BJP ticket from this constituency.
5.	Chanasma (District-Patan)	17	Incumbent Minister Dilipbhai Thakor, who represents this constituency in the assembly, is contesting against Raghunathbhai Desai of Congress.
6.	Patan (District-Patan)	18	Ranchhodbhai Desai from BJP is contesting Kiritkumar Patel of INC.

7.	Mahesana (District- Mahesana)	25	Deputy Chief Minister Nitin Patel is contesting from this constituency. Congress has fielded Jivabhai Patel against him.
8.	Becharaji (District- Mahesana)	23	Former Minister Rajanikant Patel of BJP is contesting against Bharatji Thakore of INC.
9.	Idar(Reserved for SC) (District-Sabarkantha)	28	Assembly speaker Ramanlal Vora had contested assembly election in 2012. BJP has fielded Hitendra Kanodiyaa (Gujarati Film Actor) in his place and Manibhai Baghela of INC is also in fray.

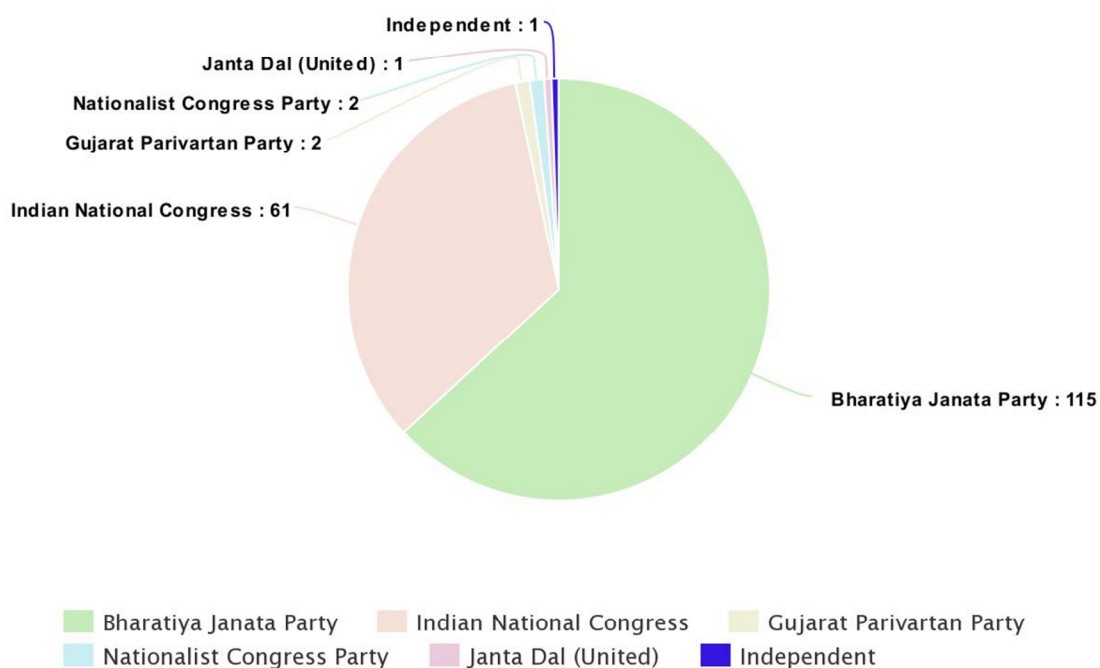

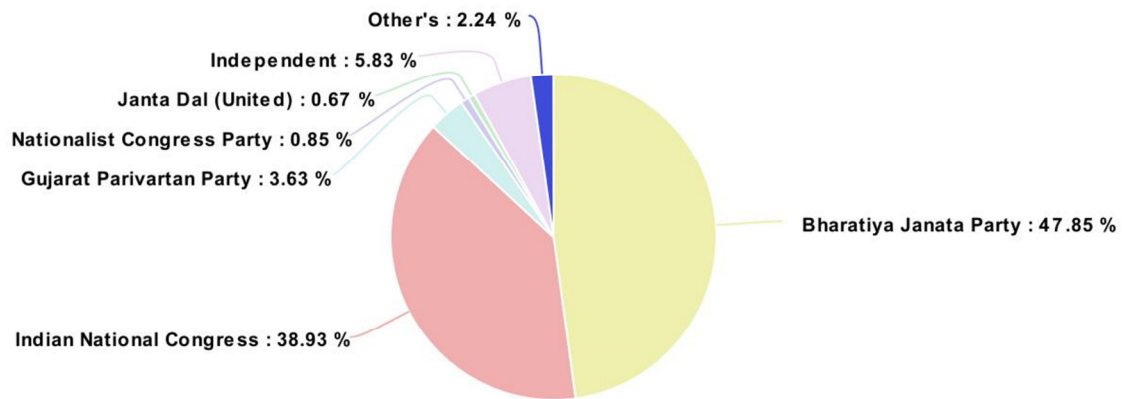
