The maximum age limit is **21 to 50 years** as on 31.3.2010

The applicant may note that working on casual assignment basis for NSD: AIR will not confer any right for regularization of services in this organization. The booking will be offered from time to time on the basis of the requirements of the organization and will not normally exceed six days in a month.

A non-refundable processing fee of Rs.300/- for General Category and Rs.225/- for SC/ST/OBC candidates will be charged. The bank draft in favour of Director General (News), AIR, New Delhi payable at New Delhi may be sent alongwith the application.

There would be a combined written test for the empanelment of Newsreader-cum-translator to judge **the knowledge of language, translation ability and knowledge of current affairs. The answer should be given in the respective language.**

The combined written test for the empanelment of Newsreader-cum-Translator in **Hindi, Sanskrit, Urdu, Malayalam, Tamil, Marathi, Gujarati, Assamese, Arunachali, Bengali, Oriya, Nepali, Punjabi, Dogri and Kashmiri languages** will be held in the month of **April 2010**.

The written test for the empanelment of casual **English Newsreader** will also be held in April 2010. The written test will judge the knowledge of language, general knowledge and current affairs.

Candidates securing 50% and above marks in the written examination will be called for audition/voice test. Those securing 50 per cent or more marks in the audition/voice test will be called for the interview before being placed on the panel.

The list of eligible candidates will be put on the NSD: AIR Website along with the venue of the test. All the applicants are requested to constantly check the website on regular basis after **8th April 2010**. **No call letter will be delivered to the candidates for the written examination and audition/voice test.**

Result of the written test as well as date of voice test of those who qualify in the written test will be put on the website. The final result will be available on the NSD:AIR website www.newsonair.com.
